Best wishes to the Football Team who will be playing their fixtures on Tuesday 30th January and Friday 2nd March.

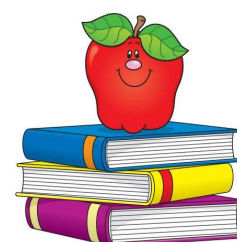
Well done to...

Photos

Administering Medication

Please note that staff will only be able to administer 'Prescription' medication i.e. medication which has been prescribed for your child by a GP. On all occasions an administering of medication form must be completed. A copy of this form is on our website.

Allergies

Please avoid sending 'Nutella Spread' in your child's lunch or snack as some children are allergic to the nuts it contains.

Door Access System Remember during school hours the front door is locked. If your child is coming in to school outside normal times make sure they have been able to get into the building. Do not drop off and drive off! This is particularly important with Festival coming up.

Collection If your child is being collected by someone different i.e another parent, friend etc school must be informed either by telephone or note. If you are collecting your child early you must sign the book in the foyer.

Snow/Ice
