### Staff News

**Early Morning Supervision** is available as normal in the school hall from 8.30 am each morning. Teachers supervise in the classroom from 8.45am.

**Additional** early cover is available from 8.15am - 8.30am at a cost of 50p each morning. Mrs Wright or Mrs Wilson will supervise the children at this time in the staffroom.

**Door Access** From 9am until 3pm the front door of the school is locked using an access system. If your child arrives at school between these times please make sure they have gained access to the building before you drive off.

**After School Care** continues to be available Monday - Friday from 2- 3pm for P1 and P2 children and Thursday and Friday for P3 children. The cost is £2.50 per day, which includes a snack. Please forward payment for this in a sealed envelope clearly showing your child's name and the days on which care is needed. It would be preferred if this could be forwarded at the beginning of the month. If this is not possible it should be sent on Monday morning for the incoming week.

**Reminder P3** stay until 3pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

**Home Time P1, P2 (everyday) and P3** (Thursdays and Fridays) will go to the gate a couple of minutes before 2pm in the anticipation that all children will have left by 2pm to enable infant teachers to have a prompt start to their afternoon class. Any child not collected will join the afterschool club.

**Absences for appointments etc.** All children leaving during the school day for appointments etc must be signed out with the school secretary.

**Swimming** for P6 at Cookstown Leisure Centre commences on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September. Children can have school dinner or packed lunch on return to school.

**Swimming** for P5 at Dungannon Leisure Centre commences on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September.
